ALIVE

A → **L** → **I** → **V** → **E**
 At fertilization · Life = person · Inalienable right · Vulnerable · Expansion risk

OPENING FRAME → START HERE

If the unborn is a human being, then abortion ends an innocent human life — and that life deserves protection.

ALIVE PATH

- A AT FERTILIZATION**
Science: a unique human organism begins at fertilization (distinct DNA, continuous development).
- ↓
- L LIFE = PERSON**
Personhood: Scripture and natural law treat the unborn as known, valued persons (Ps 139; Jer 1:5).
- ↓
- I INALIENABLE RIGHT**
Right to life is first — without it, no other right matters.
- ↓
- V VULNERABLE**
Just societies protect those who cannot speak for themselves (Prov 31:8–9).
- ↓
- E EXPANSION RISK**
Once value depends on size, dependency, or “wantedness,” the elderly and disabled are next.

COUNTERS

THEY SAY
“My body, my choice”



YOU SAY
Two bodies. Pregnancy involves a distinct human with unique DNA. Bodily autonomy does not include a right to end another’s life.

THEY SAY
“It’s not a person yet”



YOU SAY
Personhood games have a bloody history. If it’s human and alive, the burden is on you to justify killing it.

THEY SAY
“What about rape / hard cases?”



YOU SAY
Acknowledge the trauma. The child is still innocent. Hard cases make bad general policy — and most abortions are not hard cases.

THEY SAY
“Women will die without access”



YOU SAY
Treat life-threatening conditions. Pro-life ethic protects mother and child; it rejects elective abortion as healthcare.

CLOSE → → Lead with compassion, then science. Offer support — don’t only argue. Memory hook: ALIVE.
