Government is a necessary servant and a dangerous master. Liberty, property, and thrift beat bureaucratic control.

- L LESSON OF KINGS**
1 Samuel 8 — centralized power taxes, conscripts, and takes.
- ↓
- I INDUSTRY & PROPERTY**
Property, work, and free exchange create wealth (Ex 20:15; Prov).
- ↓
- M MAXIMIZE LIBERTY**
Free will implies government protects rights — it doesn't micromanage souls.
- ↓
- I INCENTIVES WIN**
Bureaucracy wastes; markets discover knowledge government can't.
- ↓
- T THRIFT OVER DEBT**
Borrowing against children is generational theft (Prov 22:7; 13:22).

| <p>THEY SAY
“Government provides necessary services”</p> | → | <p>YOU SAY
Yes — core ones: defense, courts, policing (Rom 13). Most else is better private or local.</p> |
| <p>THEY SAY
“Without regulation, exploitation”</p> | → | <p>YOU SAY
Fraud and force are already illegal. Competition and reputation discipline better than endless rules.</p> |
| <p>THEY SAY
“We need safety nets”</p> | → | <p>YOU SAY
Charity and family first. Government monopolies often trap poverty; civil society humanizes help.</p> |
| <p>THEY SAY
“The rich don't pay their share”</p> | → | <p>YOU SAY
The top earners already fund most income taxes. “Fair share” often means “higher share.”</p> |

CLOSE → → Argue competence + morality. Memory hook: LIMIT.
