OPENING FRAME → START HERE

Healthcare is a moral good — monopoly government medicine rations by queue, blunts innovation, and puts politics between patient and doctor.

CURES PATH**C****CHOICE**

Patients and doctors need exit options. One payer means one political customer.

**U****UNLEASH MARKETS**

Transparent prices and competition lower costs where patients can actually choose (e.g. LASIK).

**R****RATIONING HONESTY**

Waiting lists are denial of care with better PR. Ask who dies on the list.

**E****EXPAND INNOVATION**

America's biomedical engine serves the world. Price-control monopsony starves tomorrow's cures.

**S****STEWARD THE VULNERABLE**

Help the poor with targeted aid and charity — not by nationalizing everyone's body.

COUNTERS**THEY SAY**

"Healthcare is a human right"

**YOU SAY**

A duty to help ≠ a right to a government monopoly. Positive entitlements conscript others' labor and money.

THEY SAY

"Other countries cover everyone"

**YOU SAY**

They ration by waiting and limit new therapies. Coverage on paper ≠ timely care.

THEY SAY

"Medicare for All is simpler"

**YOU SAY**

Centralizing complexity relocates it into politics, queues, and influence — it doesn't erase scarcity.

THEY SAY

"Markets leave people behind"

**YOU SAY**

Markets + targeted aid + charity beat monopoly. The uninsured need help, not destroyed choice.

CLOSE → → Lead with compassion for the sick, then CURES. Memory hook: CURES.
